

Sixes for Solar - Contest Terms & Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to the Contest - "Sixes for Solar" featured in any publications, online services, and events organized by Vikram Solar Ltd (or a third party on Vikram Solar Ltd's behalf and for the sake of this contest, Vikram Solar Limited will be referred to as Vikram Solar). By entering the "Sixes for Solar" contest, entrants accept these terms and conditions, along with any specific instructions and details provided through electronic messages, websites, or any other form of communication ("contest information"). Vikram Solar reserves the right to modify, amend, or cancel the contest or these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice. However, any significant changes affecting participant eligibility, selection, or benefits shall be communicated via email or official contest platforms.

1. General Contest Information

- a) Organizer: Vikram Solar is the official organizer of the "Sixes for Solar" contest.
- b) Contest Name: The official contest name is "Sixes for Solar. Each six hit by KKR during the contest period contributes towards solarization benefits under this campaign, subject to these Terms.
- c) Contest Period: The contest will run during Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) matches in the 2026 T20 League season, commencing from 28 March 2026 and ending with KKR's last match in the tournament.
- d) Objective:
 - Ensure nationwide visibility of Vikram Solar modules and their functionality.
 - Promote Solar energy adoption..
 - The number of beneficiaries and installations shall be determined at Vikram Solar's sole discretion, taking into account campaign performance, logistics, feasibility, and internal allocation policies.
- e) Participation does not require any purchase.

This contest is hosted and promoted on Vikram Solar and KKR digital platforms solely as part of a brand association and shall not be construed as being sponsored, endorsed, or administered by KKR or its affiliates.

2. Entry & Selection Process

- a) Entry Method:
 - Participation through social media post announcements with a registration link to the landing page - [Vikram Solar: Sunshine that power champions](#)
- b) Eligibility Criteria:

- Participants must be Indian residents aged 21 years or above.
- The participant must have ownership or lawful possession rights over the residential property where installation is proposed and shall represent and warrant that such rights are clear, marketable, and free from encumbrances, disputes, or third-party claims. The property may be registered in the name of a father, mother, spouse, or next of kin, subject to necessary consents.
- A valid monthly electricity bill.
- Adequate land or rooftop space for installing solar modules/system. Minimum shadow-free rooftop area of at least 325 sq. ft. must be available.
- Good roof condition with minimal shading from trees, adjacent buildings or structures, water tanks, parapet walls, poles, overhead installations, or any other obstructions or environmental factors that may affect solar irradiation and system performance.
- An up-to-date electrical system.
- ID proof for age and address verification.
- Minimum sanctioned load of the premises must be greater than 3 kW.
- Employees of Vikram Solar, its affiliates, distributors, channel partners, and their immediate family members are ineligible.
- Participant must have clear and marketable title, possession, and necessary rights/consents over the installation premises.
- All statutory approvals, including DISCOM/grid connectivity approvals, if required, must be obtainable for the property.
- Only standalone houses shall be eligible. Flats, gated societies, or shared rooftops shall not qualify.

c) Selection Mechanism:

- Initial screening through an in-house lead management team to verify eligibility criteria via phone calls. 2 call attempts will be made on 2 consecutive business days during working hours.
- Collection of documents for first-round eligibility verification: Government ID proof (age and address), electricity bill, and geo-location along with a photograph of the terrace. Documents to be submitted in the email id sixesforsolar@vikramsolar.com within 2 days of the call.
- Winners will be selected randomly from eligible participants by the Independent External Consultant team based on the total sixes hit by KKR.
- The randomization process will be audited and supervised by Independent External Consultant to ensure fairness and transparency. Vikram Solar reserves the right to adopt, modify, or replace the selection methodology to ensure fairness and operational feasibility.
- As winner announcements will be made throughout the tournament, the number of winners selected at each stage shall be determined by Vikram Solar at its sole discretion, based on campaign considerations, operational feasibility, and internal allocation planning, and shall not be linked to any predefined inventory of modules.

- Eligible participants shall be forwarded to channel partners/ distributors based on location for physical site recce.
- Installation address to match with electricity bill address.
- Recce attempt to be taken twice within 2 business days in a week
- Distributors to verify eligibility and communicate to participants that their house qualifies for selection.
- If a participant's property does not meet the eligibility conditions (e.g., insufficient rooftop space, heavy shading, structural issues, or lack of required approvals), they will be disqualified and replaced by the next eligible participant from the backup list.
- Winners will be confirmed by Vikram Solar through official communication channels.
- A backup list of winners may be maintained at Vikram Solar's discretion.
- Vikram Solar reserves the right to reject any participant at any stage without assigning reasons where installation is deemed unviable, unsafe, non-compliant, or commercially impractical. Such decision shall be final and binding and shall not give rise to any claim against Vikram Solar.
- Upon finalization and audit closure of winners based on the Contest criteria, no further winners shall be selected or substituted. In the event a selected winner is unable or unwilling to proceed, such selection shall lapse without replacement.

Final Selection & Acknowledgment:

- The final confirmed winners must sign an Acknowledgment Agreement, confirming their acceptance of:
 - Responsibility for installation at the site/location ,
 - Consent for media coverage (pre-installation, installation, and post-installation) for Vikram Solar's promotional campaigns.
- Execution of a separate binding agreement with the authorized distributor/installer, which shall be a condition precedent to installation.

3. Prize Details & Installation

a) Prize:

- Winners will receive Vikram Solar PV modules as part of a standardized on-grid solar system with a maximum installed capacity of up to 3 kW (which shall be a cap and not a guaranteed capacity), as determined based on site feasibility.
- Solar modules are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
- The system configuration (including number of modules) shall be determined by Vikram Solar or its authorized distributor based on technical feasibility.
- Vikram Solar shall bear the cost limited to the Standard Scope (as defined below), which may include solar PV modules and such other components as determined pursuant to the Site Recce and internal allocation. Provided

however that Vikram Solar's role shall be limited to facilitation and funding of such Standard Scope and it shall not be construed as the executing contractor.

- Installation timeline: Estimated between 2 days to 1 week from site readiness. Commissioning may take up to approximately 30 days, subject to regulatory approvals and external dependencies. All timelines are indicative and non-binding.
- Only on-grid solar systems shall be provided. Off-grid systems may be provided only in regions where grid connectivity is not available, at Vikram Solar's discretion.

b) Prize Description and Value:

- The Prize includes standard installation and system components; however, battery systems shall only be included in case of off-grid installations, where applicable.
- Indicative system value will range as per the market rate for a 3 kW system, subject to market variations and site-specific factors.
- The system components, configuration, and capacity (up to a maximum of 3 kW) are indicative in nature and shall be determined by Vikram Solar's authorized distributor/dealer based on the Site Recce conducted at the participant's premises. All components (Including the Vikram Solar- Solar PV modules) shall be supplied by the authorized distributor/dealer. Vikram Solar reserves the absolute and unfettered right, at its sole discretion, to approve, modify, vary, or deviate from the proposed system design and components based on site conditions, engineering requirements, availability, or commercial considerations, and no participant shall have any right to insist on any specific components or configuration.

c) Installation Process:

- Installation shall be undertaken by authorized vendors/distributors engaged by Vikram Solar. The distributor will oversee site assessment and installation execution.
- Vikram Solar shall act solely as a facilitator under this initiative and shall not be deemed the executing contractor.
- All installation, workmanship, safety, and execution-related obligations and liabilities shall vest solely with the distributor/installer under a separate agreement with the participant.
- All installation timelines are indicative and subject to:
 - i. Weather conditions
 - ii. Regulatory approvals
 - iii. Vendor availability
 - iv. Site readiness
- Installation shall be completed within a reasonable period, subject to external dependencies. Vikram Solar shall not be liable for any delays.

- The distributor/dealer shall facilitate coordination with relevant government authorities, and the net metering process shall be managed by the distributor. However, the participant shall be solely responsible for providing complete, accurate, and timely documentation and information as may be required for such process, and submission of the same shall constitute a condition precedent to initiation and scheduling of installation. Any failure, deficiency, or delay attributable to the participant in furnishing such documents or information shall result in a corresponding extension of timelines, and Vikram Solar shall bear no liability whatsoever for any delay, deferment, or non-completion arising therefrom.
- Prior to installation, the authorized distributor/dealer shall provide the participant with a written scope and cost document clearly distinguishing (i) the Standard Scope covered under this initiative, and (ii) any Non-Standard Scope along with applicable costs. Installation shall proceed only after the participant's written confirmation of such scope and costs.
- The standard system scope ("Standard Scope") shall mean the components and installation required for a solar rooftop system up to the approved capacity (up to 3 kW), as determined pursuant to the Site Recce and in accordance with Vikram Solar's internal allocation and commercial arrangement with its authorized distributor/dealer. The cost of such Standard Scope shall be borne by Vikram Solar directly with the authorized distributor/dealer.
- Any requirement for additional components, materials, services, or modifications beyond the Standard Scope, including but not limited to structural reinforcements, additional wiring, earthing enhancements, elevated mounting structures, or other site-specific requirements identified during or after the Site Recce ("Non-Standard Scope"), shall be communicated to the participant and shall be undertaken only upon the participant's approval. The cost of such Non-Standard Scope shall be borne solely by the participant.
- Installation shall not proceed unless the participant has (i) executed the required agreement with the distributor/installer, and (ii) accepted any additional cost implications in writing, where applicable.
- For avoidance of doubt, the determination of Standard Scope shall be final and binding as per Vikram Solar's internal approval based on the Site Recce, and the participant shall have no claim against Vikram Solar in relation to the inclusion or exclusion of any component from such Standard Scope.

d) Cost Exclusions:

Without prejudice to the Standard Scope defined above, the following shall NOT be covered by Vikram Solar and shall be borne solely by the winner:

- Structural repairs or reinforcement of rooftop
- Civil work, waterproofing, or modifications
- Extended wiring beyond standard limits

- Grid connectivity fees, net metering charges, approvals, and government fees
- Battery systems (unless explicitly approved)
- Any additional components not included in standard system design
- Costs arising due to site-specific constraints
- Any cost not expressly included in the standard system scope shall be deemed excluded

4. Winner Notification & Publicity

a) Winners will be notified through the contact information provided during registration throughout the tournament.

b) The list of winners will be published on Vikram Solar's official social media pages and website.

c) Participants agree to allow Vikram Solar to feature their names, images, and property photos/videos in marketing campaigns.

d) Content related to the contest (participant submissions, testimonials, and installation experiences) will be the property of Vikram Solar.

e) Winners must respond within two business days to confirm acceptance. Failure to respond may result in disqualification.

f) By participating, entrants grant Vikram Solar the right to use their names, images and testimonials for promotional purposes without additional compensation on an irrevocable, worldwide basis.

5. Legal & Compliance Terms.

a) Participants must ensure that their property meets structural and technical requirements for solar installation.

b) Participants agree to provide accurate and truthful information during registration and verification.

c) Vikram Solar reserves the right to disqualify any participant providing false information or violating contest rules. Vikram Solar is the official organizer of the "Sixes for Solar" contest and it is not fulfilled by Kolkata Knight Riders team/ KNIGHT RIDERS SPORTS PRIVATE LIMITED in any manner.

d) Vikram Solar is not responsible for technical issues, delays, or failures before, during, or after the contest period. Every six (6) sixes hit by KKR shall be considered for the purpose of determining potential beneficiaries under this campaign, subject to eligibility, verification, and these Terms & Conditions.

e) Vikram Solar distributors/channel partners will conduct two recce attempts for verification.

f) Flats in gated communities or apartments are not eligible.

g) Remote locations that are not well connected to city transport may be deemed ineligible at Vikram Solar's discretion.

h) Participant data will be collected and used in accordance with Vikram Solar's privacy policy. The collected information will be used for contest administration and future marketing initiatives.

i) This contest is no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook, Instagram, X, or any other social media platform.

j) Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or in connection with these terms and conditions, including their validity, interpretation, or breach, shall first be attempted to be resolved amicably through mutual negotiations between the parties. If the dispute is not resolved within thirty (30) days of such negotiations, it shall be according to the prevailing laws of India.

k) Governing Law & Dispute Resolution:

- The contest is governed by the laws of India.
- Any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Kolkata, India.
- Vikram Solar's decision on all contest-related matters shall be final and binding.

l) Vikram Solar does not guarantee:

- Electricity generation levels
- Savings on electricity bills
- Performance under specific environmental conditions

m) All performance estimates are indicative and subject to solar irradiation, weather, and usage conditions.

n) This contest is independently conducted by Vikram Solar and is not sponsored or fulfilled by Kolkata Knight Riders or Knight Riders Sports Private Limited.

o) Campaign messaging is promotional in nature and does not create a binding obligation to solarize a fixed number of houses.

p) Vikram Solar shall not be responsible for delays in commissioning arising from government approvals, net metering processes, or participant-side delays in documentation.

q) Vikram Solar reserves the right to disqualify any participant at any stage in case of (i) failure to provide required documents within stipulated timelines, (ii) non-cooperation during verification or site inspection, (iii) refusal to execute required agreements, or (iv) provision of false, misleading, or incomplete information.

6. Warranty & Additional Costs

a) Vikram Solar is not liable for damages, accidents, or losses arising from installation or solar module usage.

b) Standard Vikram Solar warranty policies apply for module defects caused by manufacturing issues.

c) Warranty excludes damages due to improper usage, external factors (e.g., natural disasters), or lack of maintenance.

d) Participants must cover additional installation work as specified above under Prize Description and Value and other permits.

e) Distributor must take signed acknowledgments from winners confirming their responsibility for installation costs and use of images/videos for marketing.

f) Vikram Solar Limited shall not be responsible for any installation, maintenance, or operational issues arising from the use of the prize. The winner is solely responsible for ensuring that the prize is installed, operated, and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines and all applicable laws, regulations, and safety standards. Vikram Solar Limited disclaims all warranties, whether express or implied, including but not limited to merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, and non-infringement, to the extent permitted by law.

g) Vikram Solar shall not be liable for installation-related risks, which shall be governed under the agreement between the participant and the distributor/installer.

7. Miscellaneous

a) Vikram Solar reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the contest due to operational, regulatory, or unforeseen circumstances.

b) If fraudulent activity is detected, Vikram Solar may disqualify participants and take legal action.

c) All registrations, whether successful or unsuccessful, may be treated as leads for future Vikram Solar marketing.

d) Vikram Solar reserves the right to offer non-winning participants exclusive discounts on solar installations.

e) All applicable taxes, duties, levies, surcharges, registration fees, and any other statutory or regulatory charges, as well as any necessary permits or approvals, arising from or in connection with the receipt, installation, or use of the prize shall be borne solely by the winner. Vikram Solar Limited shall have no liability whatsoever for any tax obligations imposed by any central, state, or local authorities on the participant or the winner. It is the sole responsibility of the winner to ensure compliance with all applicable tax and regulatory requirements in relation to the prize.

f) Vikram Solar Limited reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, amend, or alter the winner selection process, including but not limited to conducting a re-selection of winners or adopting an alternative selection method, in the event of technical issues, fraud, ineligibility, errors, or unforeseen circumstances affecting the fairness or integrity of the contest. Any such modifications shall be final and binding on all participants

In such cases, Vikram Solar Limited shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or inconvenience suffered by any participant as a result of such cancellation, suspension, or modification.

h) Vikram Solar's decision on all contest-related matters is final and binding.

i) The number of sixes hit by KKR in each match will be taken from online sites keeping track of scorecards.

j) Vikram Solar Limited strictly prohibits any fraudulent, misleading, or deceptive activity in connection with the contest. Any participant found to have provided false, inaccurate, or misleading information, engaged in unfair practices, manipulated the contest process, or attempted to gain an unfair advantage shall be immediately disqualified. Vikram Solar Limited reserves the right to take appropriate legal action, including civil and/or criminal proceedings, against any participant found guilty of fraud, misrepresentation, or any other unlawful conduct.

j) If a participant encounter someone impersonating Vikram Solar, they must report it to the CRM team at the email given on our official website. Any payment made to such impersonators will not hold Vikram Solar liable in any manner.

k) The physical recce conducted by the distributor will be free of charge.

l) Vikram Solar Limited, its affiliates, directors, officers, employees, agents, and representatives shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, or special damages, including but not limited to personal injury, property damage, or financial loss arising from participation in the contest, the installation, operation, or

use of the solar modules, or any failure, delay, or inability to install the solar modules for any reason beyond its reasonable control. By participating in the contest, the participant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Vikram Solar Limited from and against any claims, liabilities, damages, costs, or expenses, including reasonable legal fees, arising from any breach of these terms and conditions, misrepresentation, or violation of applicable laws by the participant.

m) If any provision of these terms and conditions is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable under applicable law, such provision shall be deemed modified to the minimum extent necessary to render it valid and enforceable. If such modification is not possible, the affected provision shall be severed from the terms, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect

n) Winners will be contacted only through the official email ID specified in the document.

o) By accepting the prize, the winner expressly agrees that Vikram Solar Limited may use their name, image, likeness, photographs, and statements for promotional, advertising, and marketing purposes in any media, without any further compensation, notice, or approval, except where prohibited by law. If a winner does not wish to participate in such promotions, they must notify Vikram Solar Limited in writing within seven (7) days of being declared a winner.

p) Vikram Solar shall not be liable for failure or delay due to events beyond its control including natural disasters, government actions, supply disruptions, or other force majeure events

q) System specifications (including components such as inverter, cables, mounting structures, earthing, etc.) shall be standardized as per Vikram Solar's approved bill of materials and may vary depending on roof type (RCC/sheet) and site conditions.

r) Variations in structure design, cable length, or auxiliary components may occur depending on site-specific engineering requirements.

s) The distributor/installer shall be solely responsible for installation execution, including safety, workmanship, and compliance with applicable laws, and shall maintain adequate insurance coverage for personnel, third-party liability, and installation-related risks. Vikram Solar shall have no liability in respect thereof.

t) Participants located in the Union Territories of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, and North Eastern States (excluding Assam), shall not be eligible for participation under this Contest.

By participating in the "Sixes for Solar" contest, participants confirm that they have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms & Conditions.
